

SCAA ONLINE ART SHOP CALL FOR ART SPECIFICATIONS

ELIGIBILITY

South County Art Association's online Art Shop welcomes applications from all of its members in good standing. 2D & 3D Work is selected by a committee using criteria that shows exemplary execution of design, quality craftsmanship, creative use of materials, marketability, as well as how each piece contributes to each seasonal collection as a whole. Each collection will be inspired by a visually evocative theme, this year, we've chosen a set of themes all about the colors that represent the New England seasons.

SALES

Members receive 70% of sale price, SCAA retains 30%.

MEDIA CATEGORIES

Accepted media categories include: ceramics, paintings, photography, prints, jewelry, mixed media, decorative fiber, wearable fiber, glass, paper, baskets, and wood.

ACCEPTANCE CRITERIA

All work must fit within one of the following accepted media categories: ceramics, paintings, photography, prints, jewelry, mixed media, decorative fiber, wearable fiber, glass, paper, baskets, or wood. All work must be original and made by hand by the applicant. SCAA encourages one-of-a-kind, work created as a series and/or limited edition work.

Each Applicant may have three entries

For 2D Artists, each entry may consist of:

1. one original work
2. a series of up to three unique but related pieces or
3. one limited edition work with up to three copies
4. all 2D work may be up to 20" x 24" (including frame)

For 3D Artists, each entry may consist of:

1. one original work
2. a series of up to six unique but related pieces or
3. one limited edition work with up to three copies
4. all 3D work needs to be easily transportable

SUBMISSION PROCESS

1. Go to <https://www.southcountyart.org/call-for-art--store.html>. If the link doesn't work go to southcountyart.org > exhibits > call for art | store.
2. Fill out the form.
3. Upload a photo of your artwork(s). To best present your piece to the jury, make sure to upload high quality, high resolution .jpg photos (above 400K) of your artwork. Save your .jpg with your last name as the filename.

If your art is accepted:

3-D pieces will be professionally photographed at SCAA to create a consistent look for the store.

2-D pieces. We will use the entry photos that you upload in the form to be put in our online store. If framed, include the frame in your photo.

By entering your piece, you consent to dropping off your accepted piece(s) within the timeframe noted. Any deviation from the instructions nullifies your submission. If you have any questions, we're here to help. Email info@southcountyart.org. If you have been accepted, you'll receive an email by the jurying deadline. Unaccepted entries will not be notified. To help you prepare, following is the 2020-21 schedule of deadlines and themes.

Theme 1 – Orange Spice

Call for Art: July 29

Entries Accepted: July 30 - August 25

Jurying by: September 1

Accepted pieces delivered: September 2 – 6 (during open hours)

Online on September 23

Theme 1 runs from September 23 – December 8

Theme 2 – Cool Blues

Call for Art: October 14

Entries Accepted: October 15 - November 10

Jurying by: November 16

Accepted pieces delivered: November 17 – 21 (during open hours)

Online on December 9

Theme 2 runs from December 9 – March 9, 2021

Theme 3 – Spring Greens

Call for Art: January 13

Entries Accepted: January 14 - February 8

Jurying by: February 15

Accepted pieces delivered: February 16 - 20 (during open hours)

Online on March 10

Theme 3 runs from March 10 – June 8, 2021

Theme 4 – Summer Sunshine

Call for Art: April 14

Entries Accepted: April 15 - May 10

Jurying by: May 17

Accepted pieces delivered: May 18 - 22 (during open hours)

Online on June 9

Theme 4 runs from June 9 – September 8, 2021
