

## Drawing to Painting on Canvas Materials List

### Drawing Needs:

Pencils / Kneaded Eraser

An 18" steel ruler

Pencils: Pls. bring 2B mechanical pencils or better-Papermate Sharpwriter #2 (these yellow mechanical pencils are sold in packs. They are inexpensive and I favor these above all).

Paper for drawing- 1 pad of 9 X 12" tracing paper  
(I recommend Daly Rowney brand 28 lb)

1 pad of 9 X 12" quality drawing paper. (There are many brands to choose from but the paper must NOT have a smooth or polished surface. The pad should instead have a vellum finish). I recommend a Strathmore Mixed Media pad.

### Painting Needs:

Thin charcoal sticks

Canvas or Primed Wood Panel Canvas 8 X 10, 9 X 12, 12 X 12 or 11 X 14 inches

Paints: Acrylic paint in tube sets or bought individually with the classic array of colors. (pls. note that more expensive tubes yield better paint like Liquitex Professional Heavy Body paints) Include black, white, paynes gray, emerald green, raw umber and burnt sienna. (The same colors apply to students using oil paints)

Brushes: use acrylic informed brushes with an array of sizes. A #12 or #10 round brush is required and also include a small brush for detail work. (Oil painters use oil paint informed brushes with the same specifications)

1 container of Pouring Medium. (Matte is preferred as opposed to Glossy) Medium is used in acrylics as a paint "extender". (Oil students pls. bring Medium you are familiar with like Stand oil mixed with Turpentine)

Palette: Best choice palettes now come in pads. Jack Richeson Grey Matters paper palettes are excellent.

Acrylic painters: 2 Containers for water. Please keep these relatively small for space concerns. (Oil painters pls bring glass containers)

Paper towel or rags.
