## Tools for class:

You most likely have many of the items listed below, if not don't stress out, I will be going over the tools and materials on the first day of class.

### Please bring on the first day of class:

a notebook for sketching  
pencils, eraser permanent marker  
any printed resource material you can gather up that  
has multiple views of the elements you want to incorporate in your designs

### For the following classes...

#### for making patterns:

tyvek paper for pattern making & cutting stencils  
x-acto cutter with a new blade  
scissors

#### for making sprig molds and texture rollers:

2 – 6" square bats or ceramic tiles  
shaping tools for clay  
carving tools for clay  
fluffy brush for dusting cornstarch  
small lidded container of cornstarch  
pony roller  
clear plastic shoebox with a lid to use as a damp box with your name on it  
makeup sponges

#### for attaching & decorating:

fine mist spray bottle (travel size, found at drug stores or used to spritz hair products)  
small 4" tall squeeze bottle with white vinegar  
slip trailing bottles  
covered container for slip  
any cone 6 underglaze that you want to use and have tested with our clear glaze or your own  
clear glaze over it
