To better plan your assemblage piece, the box can be picked up prior to the beginning of class from SCAA during open hours Wednesdays - Sundays from 1-5pm. If you aren't able to pick up a box beforehand, you can start planning by using the box dimensions and ideas below.**

Dimensions are as follows:

Outside dimensions including door:

14 7/8" tall, 11 3/4" wide, 2 1/2" deep

Inside dimensions:

14 1/4" tall, 11 1/16" wide, 2" deep

You will need:

- An idea, a theme, a feeling, or a life event, for example. Is there a story you'd like to tell?
- Your "treasures" and found objects.
- Scans of any personal photos. You may also use magazine or newspaper photos.
- Decorative papers. These will provide rich backgrounds of color, pattern, and texture.
- Paints you might like to use in your specific color preferences. I would avoid tube acrylics. I find that small bottles of acrylic craft paints are perfect. They come in a huge range of colors and are easy to transport and mix.
- I will supply everything else you will need to work on your assemblage during class. We'll have cutting mats and tools, drawing and measuring tools, glues and finish materials, containers and palettes, etc.
- Feel free to bring any materials you feel comfortable working with.
