## MATERIALS:

Please keep in mind the better quality the pigments, the better the color mixing. The word hue after the color is a weaker form. Winton is a student grade, more inferior. The more expensive versions are better. I use Winsor \& Newton or anything pricewise comparable. Same for brushes, a good bristle brush will have the strength to hold the paint. Jerrys Artarama and Blick usually have paint and brush sales. I prefer Jerry's on No Main St. Prov. Near Whole foods and Mc Donalds.

Your tubes of colors must include - any type of white, yellow, and a red, alizarin crimson, yellow ochre, burnt sienna, burnt umber, greens such as viridian and perm green, blues including ultramarine, cobalt, cerulean, and a black.

Bristle brushes round or flat, various sizes.
Gamsol paint thinner not turpentine
Paper towels or rags
Linseed oil or a paint medium such as Galkyd or Galkyd light. Liquin has a strong odor, do not use.
Pad of canvas paper $9 \times 12$ or larger
Wide bottom glass or cup
Pencil
Eraser
Palette knife
Masking tape
A wooden palette
A sturdy surface to tape your canvas paper to
